

## Sparkling & Champagne

- Prosecco Di Conegliano-Valdobbiadene, Bernardi, Veneto, Italy** 29  
Clean, fresh and elegant with delicate bubbles that enhance its subtle citrusy fruit and touch of marzipan, dangerously drinkable!
- Grande Reserve Brut NV, Devaux, Côte des Bar, Champagne, France** 52  
A boutique champagne producer specialising in Pinot Noir dominated wines. A lovely richness to the nose, baked apple, vanilla, lively acidity & finesse.
- Ruinart Blanc de Blanc NV, Ruinart, Champagne, France** 89  
A blend of 100% Premier Cru Chardonnay from the best of recent vintages. A nose of brioche, French toast and roasted almonds & on the palate the wine is very supple and harmonious, with notes of honey and minerals on the long, finish. The definition of finesse.
- La Rosita Brut NV, Lobban, Barcelona, Spain** 33.5  
Delicious sparkling rosé by a Scottish female winemaker in Spain! Predominantly Grenache & made in the traditional champagne method. Strawberries & cream with nougaty complexity.
- Cuvée Rosé NV, Devaux, Côte des Bar, Champagne, France** 65  
A decadent & delicious wine with very fine bubbles, a creamy mouth-feel, raspberries, strawberries & hints of hazelnut.

## White

- Bergerie de la Bastide Blanc 2017, Southern France** 20.5  
Discreet and elegant on the nose, it reveals typical notes of dried herbs, white flowers with a touch of lemon. The palate is bright with a lovely and fresh citrusy bite.
- Gran Cerdo Blanco 2017, Gonzalo Grijalba, Rioja, Spain** 22.5  
Beyond the Viura base of this wine, varieties like Sauvignon Blanc and Muscat add some delicious fragrant nuances. A funky, fresh and fruity natural wine.
- Casa de Paços 2017, Quinta de Paços, Vinho Verde, Portugal** 25  
A blend of Loureiro & Arinto, Fleshy melon & light tropical fruit on the nose following through to the palate with vibrant acidity and excellent minerality.
- Picpoul de Pinet 2017, Château de la Mirande, Languedoc, France** 26  
Referred to as the 'Muscadet of the South', with its minerality & almost saltiness on the nose from its close proximity to the sea. Surprising complex white with flavours of pear, citrus fruit & fennel, and a zesty finish.
- Torrontes/Riesling 2017, Amalaya, Salta, Argentina** 26.5  
Intense and complex with aromas of citrus and grapefruit typical of Torrontes. Delicate and silky on the palate with great freshness and crisp acidity on the distinctly mineral finish.
- Godello Do Monterrei 2017, Mara Martin, Galicia, Spain** 28.5  
From one of the most influential producers in Galicia, this delicious and unusual wine from the Godello grape is bone dry with notes of apple & pear and a citrus tang on the finish.
- Gran Passione Bianco 2017, IGT, Veneto** 29  
A blend of Garganega & Pinot Bianco. Much like its red sibling this white is a truly gorgeous wine. With a lovely floral bouquet and hints of vanilla on the nose, dry, crisp and fresh on the palette with ripe fruit flavours which balance out the acidity perfectly.
- Cora 2017, Loxarel, Penedès, Spain** 29.5  
In Greek mythology Cora means a young & virgin maiden – a perfect name for this delicate & elegant wine. A blend of Muscat d'Alexandria & Xarel.lo it has a nose evoking honeysuckle, white flowers tropical fruit & peach. Fresh & silky on the palate with a lingering finish.
- Verdicchio 'Costa Verde' 2017, Tavignana, Italy** 30  
Lovely classic style - white peach and floral notes on the nose continuing onto the palate with citrus & stone fruit, finishing with hints of bitter almond.
- Les Pierrières 1er Cotes de Blaye 2017, Château Beaumont, Bordeaux, France** 31  
Sweet grapefruit & subtle buttery notes on the nose, textured & creamy on the palate with tropical notes & lovely tang on the finish. (semillon/sauvignon blend)
- Viognier 2017, Maison Nicolas Perrin, Northern Rhone, France** 31  
When the heavyweights like Nicolas Jaboulet and Marc Perrin (Chateau de Beaucastel) meet, the outcome can only be one – fireworks. Aromatic yet fresh, crisp and mineral with a lovely bright finish.
- Gavi il Forte 2017, Produttori del Gavi, Piemonte, Italy** 31.5  
A well balanced Gavi, with a pale yellow colour, intense floral notes and good minerality. A great refreshing wine for a hot day or the perfect choice to go with some seafood
- Tocai Friulano 'Toh' 2017, Di Lenardo, Friuli Venezia, Italy** 32  
A gentle and approachable style of Friulano, soft, round and mouth filling. Ripe stone & exotic fruits with hints of spice and almond, a clean balancing mineral acidity and lovely length.
- Riesling 2017, Mehrlein Mittelheimer Edelmann, Rheingau, Germany** 32

This dry style of Riesling has a pure lime citrus fruit character and a stony minerality. The palate is very precise with just a hint of texture and a cleansing acidity. Perfect as an aperitif or with oily fish dishes.

- Malagousia 2017 Mylonas Winery, Attica, Greece** 33  
This aromatic grape variety was rescued from near extinction in the 1970's. It has a lovely nose of white flowers & pear with a herbal hint. Rich on the palate but with balancing acidity. Perfect match to seafood or as an aperitif
- Hobby 2016, Alentejo, Portugal** 33.5  
100% Antão Vaz, a lovely wine from this hot new region has a rich & complex character from its 4 months in French oak and its wet stone minerality is reminiscent of a fine Chablis.
- Fiano de Avellino 2017, Lapilli, Campania, Italy** 34  
A lovely golden yellow colour in the glass leads onto complex aromas of spice, apricot, orange peel, acacia and honey. Good levels of acidity keep the palate fresh and clean.
- Screaming Betty 2018, Delinquent Wine Co. Riverland, South Australia** 35.5  
With classic aromas of stone fruit and crisp pear on the nose, this thirst quenching, acid-driven, and textural Vermentino is perfect for summer drinking
- Arndorfer 'Vorgeschmack' 2017, Martin & Anna Arndorfer, Kamptal, Austria** 36.5  
A blend of Grüner Veltliner and Riesling. Fresh, lively and well balanced. Dangerously easy drinking!
- Village Chardonnay 2016, Kumeu River, N.Island, New Zealand** 37  
Kumeu River are virtually NZ wine Royalty, & are world famous for their chardonnays – rivalling great Burgundian white in style with their subtle oak influence & stone like minerality. This village chardonnay is no exception, elegant with a lovely peachy ripeness. Great as an aperitif, even better with fish or shellfish.
- Langhe Bianco 'Dragon' 2017, Luigi Baudana, Piedmont, Italy** 37.5  
Dry floral and summer grass perfumes are supported by distinct mineral notes and a savoury, lifted character on the palate. Predominantly Chardonnay & Sauvignon with touches of Riesling and Nascetta giving extra elegance & a long refreshing finish.
- Bourgogne Aligote 2017, Goisot, Cotes d'Auxerre, Burgundy, France** 38  
Aligote is the 'other' white grape variety of Burgundy. A complex wine with a nose of lemon & apple as well as notes of flint. On the palate the apple combines with a hint of spice, apricot & a toasty creaminess.
- Martiena Bianco 2016, Cantine Dei, Tuscany, Italy** 38.5  
This blend of Malvasia, Grechetto & Trebbiano has a real tutti frutti nose, tinned peaches and ripe citrus. Crisp bright and juicy on the palate, citrus and fleshy with lovely ripeness and balancing acidity.
- Weissburgunder 2016, Bender, Germany** 38.5  
Dry and elegant wine with fine aromas of stone fruit; rich and well balanced on the palate. A lively acidity and freshness provides the right undertone for a pleasant, long finish.
- Paramos de Nicasia 2016, Maquina & Tabla, Toro, Spain** 39  
A new & exciting small family run winery producing bio dynamic, interesting & finely crafted wines. This Verdejo has a touch of Malvasia and is a sensuously rich, modern Spanish white reminiscent of oaked white Bordeaux. Great label too!
- Gewürztraminer 2017, Lani, Marlborough, New Zealand** 42  
Elegant and aromatic with floral perfumes and sweet spices on the nose. Think Turkish delight and crystallised ginger! Lovely weight & texture on the palate and a sweetness that is finely balanced with its acidity.
- Albariño 2017, Zarate, Rias Baixa, Spain** 42.5  
Minerality and balance in a bottle, very focused and tight, like a good Chablis. Hidden amongst the steely character of the wine, stone fruits such as peach and apricot lurk – totally delicious!
- Terlaner Classico 2017, Cantina Terlano, Alto Adige, Italy** 45.5  
Elegant & harmonious. Ripe tropical flavours, soft white fruit and lovely floral notes with balancing acidity. The wine has a long, persistent finish. (Pinot Bianco/Chard/Sauv)
- Reto 2017, Juan Antonio Ponce, Manchuela, Spain** 44  
Something a bit different! Albilla de Manchuela is a little grown Spanish variety delivering inviting aromas of quince & citrus, it has a creamy complexity, lovely texture and cleansing acidity.
- Kerner 2017, Abbazia Di Novacella, Alto Adige** 47.5  
An aromatic varietal aged in large oak barrels. Rich aromas, floral, apricot kernel & peach characters. The palate has great texture and richness with clean balancing citrus acidity. Lovely length.
- Picarana 2017, Marañones, Madrid, Spain** 59  
The Albillo Real variety loves the sunshine seen in its lovely tropical fruit & white flower aromas. Fermentation in oak gives it weight & richness & its minerality keeps it deliciously fresh. This smart smooth wine is a great find.
- 'Brolettino' Lugana 2016, Cà dei Frati, Lombardy, Italy** 54.5  
One of the best Luganas out there, rich and peachy on the palate, with a creamy, honeyed texture lifted by a stony, mineral character. Intense and concentrated through to the fresh finish. A must try.
- Macon Villages 'Les Sardines' 2016, Domaine Robert Denogent, Burgundy, France** 58  
Aromas of red apple intertwined with toasty oak and brioche. The palate is precise with superb definition and intensity. It has racy acidity and a long finish. Classic & beautiful example
- Condrieu 2017, Pierre Gaillard, Rhone, France** 72  
A beautiful & classic wine from a much respected wine maker. Lovely perfumes of honeysuckle, lychee & white peaches. Seven to eight months in oak barriques develop its complex aromas & elegantly soft palate. Impressive purity, good acidity and a long finish.

## Rosé

- Zweigelt Rosé 2017, Huber, Austria** 31.5  
Refined, serious and simply delicious! Cherry, watermelon, ripe pear & rhubarb with a subtle spiciness. The palate is pure, fresh and clean, with concentrated fruit and lip smacking bright acidity. Wonderful length.
- Paramos de Nicasia Rosé 2016, Maquina & Tabla, Toro Spain** 41  
A blend of Garnacha, Malvasia & Tinta del Pais & aged for 6 months in very large casks before bottling. A rather riveting, red berry & rose-petal-scented, very satisfying, extremely versatile wine. The most gastronomic rosé we've ever tried.
- Bandol Rosé 2017, Domaine La Suffrene, Provence, France** 46  
A gorgeous salmon- pink rose, floral & ripe with hints of peach & strawberry. Impressive balance between the fruit and minerality and there is complexity too along with good length and finish. Dangerously drinkable.

## Red

- Bergerie de la Bastide Rouge 2017, Languedoc, France** 20.5  
Ruby red with red fruit aromas of cranberries and red cherries; it is light, clean and fresh on the palate with acidity and recurrent flavours of cassis and vanilla.
- Pinot Nero 2017, Ca' di Alte, Veneto, Italy** 22.5  
This attractive pinot puts many a Bourgogne rouge to shame with its lovely perfume of wild cherries & spice. On the palate juicy cherries & strawberries. Good length & a well-balanced bargain!
- Chaval 2017, Bobal Ecologica, Bodegas Nodus, Valencia, Spain** 23.5  
This deliciously spicy, deep-fruited wine is made organically with lots of dark fruit, clove spices and gently grippy structure - All in all a hugely satisfying drink that won't break the bank or harm the planet!
- Cerejeiras 2017, Lisbon, Portugal** 25  
A blend of Aragonéz & Cabernet Sauvignon, A bouquet of red fruits with a slightly floral edge. Full and well-balanced palate laden with fresh damson and cherries.
- Rosso Piceno "Bacchus" 2017, Ciu Ciu, Marche, Italy** 25.5  
A juicy wine, bursting with flavours of red cherries, bright raspberries, strawberries and liquorice! Uncomplicated but beautifully crafted.
- Negroamaro 'I Muri' 2017, Vigneti del Salento, Puglia, Italy** 26.5  
Its enticing rich purple colour & aromas of black cherries, blackberries and vanilla do not disappoint on the palate, with its sweet spice and velvety black cherries. Yum.
- Garnacha 2017, Viña Zorzal, Navarra, Spain** 28  
This 100% Garnacha from Navarra delivers bags of lively and juicy strawberries. It has medium weight, very soft tannins and lots of freshness.
- Beaujolais-Villages, 2017, Dominique Morel, Beaujolais, France** 29  
Clear ruby in the glass with delicate cherry perfumes. The rounded palate is full of fresh red berry fruit. Elegant, well balanced with good acidity, this is a great example of Beaujolais-Villages.
- Marcillac 'Lo Sang del Pais' 2016, Domaine du Cros, South West France** 29.5  
Healthy purple-red colour, aromas of raspberries, myrtle and red currants, medium-bodied with sharp cherry flavours underpinned by distinctive mineral notes of iron and slate. Easy-drinking but very more-ish.
- Bierzo 2017, Castro Ventosa Joven, Bierzo, Spain** 30.5  
This 100% Mencía offers stunning value for money from the up-and-coming Bierzo region in northwest Spain. It is very fruit-forward but with some mineral and meaty undertones. The attack is crunchy and grippy yet it finishes dry and clean.
- Gran Passione 2017, IGT, Veneto, Italy** 32.5  
A blend of Corvina & Merlot, much like an Amarone, the grapes are laid out to dry before squeezing to intensify the flavour. Vibrant purple in colour, rich luscious nose full of sweet ripe dark cherry, plum, vanilla and spice. Rich and velvety, with lots of juicy fruit. Very easy drinking.
- Wien 2 2017, Roman Pfaffl, Wienviertel, Austria** 34  
Delicious blend of Austria's native Zweigelt & Pinot Noir that could be mistaken for a Baby Burgandy. A smoky nose with red berry fruits & spicey notes
- Bourgueil 'Diptyque' 2016, Domaine de la Chevalerie, Loire, France** 34.5  
This 100% Cabernet Franc is delightful ! Fresh, yet intense, with a floral bouquet and flavours of raspberry and blackberry. Its lovely rounded palate has a nice bite from firm tannins. Perfect with charcuterie and aged cheeses.
- Rioja Reserva 2014, Izadi, Rioja, Spain** 35  
Shiny ruby red in colour. Rich aromatic intensity and a nice balance of red fruit, liquorice and spices, with hints of smoke in the background. Elegant and round on the palate with a long aftertaste full of floral and ripe fruit notes.
- Roxanne the Razor 2018, Delinquente Wine Co. Riverland, South Australia** 35.5  
A blend of Italian grape varieties, Nero D'Avola gives bright, juicy, dark berry fruit and Montepulciano provides elegant, savoury spice. Effortlessly delicious.

<b>Zinfandel 2016, De Loach, California, USA</b>	<b>36.5</b>
Dark in colour, this wine is rich with spice on both the nose and palate. Flavours of ripe strawberry, raspberry and blackberry blend nicely with notes of blackcurrant and molasses. This wine is full bodied with soft tannins and lingering ripe flavours of pomegranate on the finish.	
<b>El Gordito 2013, Lobban Wines, Jumilla, Spain</b>	<b>37</b>
We are a big fan of Pamela Geddes, who also makes our Rosita Brut. Our first tasting note of this Monastell/Shiraz blend was 'that's f****ng good!' – but to put it more eloquently, there is a very savoury backbone to this wine with black berry fruit, spice, toast & ripe tannins. Dangerously drinkable.	
<b>Pinotage 2016, Scali, Northern Paarl, South Africa</b>	<b>37.5</b>
An elegant style of Pinotage, bright and fresh with ripe red fruit aromas and a hint of sweet herbs. It is both youthful and refreshing with a lovely long finish.	
<b>Recantina 2017, Serafini &amp; Vidotto, Veneto, Italy</b>	<b>38</b>
Francesco Serafini brought this grape back from near extinction & it is gaining somewhat of a following. Perfumed dark blueberry & plum fruits combine with spice & earth and gamey hints. The palate is almost chocolatey, lots going on here. The finish is fresh & powerful with lovely balance making you reach for another glass!!	
<b>Ruché di Castagnole Monferrato, 2015, Montalbera, Piemonte, Italy - Vegan</b>	<b>39</b>
A delicate, fresh and elegant wine, ruby red in colour with a hint of violet. Very aromatic, with hints of rose petals, raspberries, violets & even stone fruit notes normally associated with white wines. A long finish with fruit and flower supported by a good balance of tannins. A great summer wine that can be served chilled	
<b>Coste della Sesia 2015, Colombera &amp; Gallera, Piemonte, Italy</b>	<b>41.5</b>
Fresh and floral on the nose, bright red fruit, a touch of spice, white pepper and a juicy finish. Very moreish with softer tannins and a lighter body than Nebbiolos from farther south.	
<b>Xinomavro 2012, Markovitis Winery, Naoussa, Greece</b>	<b>42</b>
In honour of our fabulous chef Georgios and actually because the wine is delicious we introduce this little Greek number from a small producer famous for his 100% Xinomavro wines. An aromatic variety with good tannic structure often likened at this level to fine Burgundian Pinot or Barolo.	
<b>Acustic 2015, Vinyes Velles Nobles, Montsant, Spain</b>	<b>44</b>
A big boned, French oaked Carignan & Garnacha blend. Rich & ripe & almost sweet to taste with an attractive purity of brambly fruit followed by plums & dark chocolate. Something to warm you on those cold winter nights!	
<b>Obidos Reserva 2012, Quinta das Cerejeiras Reserva, Obidos Region, Portugal</b>	<b>45</b>
The oldest Portuguese wine brand! Over the last 150 years Quinta das Cerejeiras only produces Reserva wines on exceptional years. The wine is aged in French oak barrels for years before release. Its blend of Castelão, Touriga Nacional & Aragonez has rich aromas & focused, developed fruit.	
<b>Phigaia 2013, Serafini &amp; Vidotto, Veneto, Italy</b>	<b>46.5</b>
This Cabernet Franc led Bordeaux blend, spends up to 18 months in oak - notes of sour cherry & liquorice on the nose with warmth & savoury notes on the finish. Round tannins & elegance. Works perfectly with our Iberico meats.	
<b>Bugalugs Shiraz 2015, Tim Smith Wines, Barossa, South Australia</b>	<b>47</b>
An Aussie term of endearment is quite fitting to this delicious, perfectly balanced but no- nonsense Barossa Shiraz. Blackberries, pepper, dark chocolate, mint & truffley goodness. Yum!	
<b>Rioja Selección 1999, Urbina, Rioja, Spain</b>	<b>47.5</b>
Old fashioned Rioja at its drinkable best. Almost amber in colour with pronounced & seductive savoury vanilla oak aromas. Concentrated ripe berries on the palate, broadening out to the savoury & sensuous.	
<b>Langhe Nebbiolo 'Rocabella' 2015, Eugenio Bocchino, Piedmont, Italy</b>	<b>48.5</b>
Red plum, red cherry, lavender and cedar on the nose. The palate has well integrated acidity and fine-grained tannins. Harmonious and very approachable with a lengthy finish.	
<b>Cabernet Sauvignon 2015, Tinto Tinto, Chile</b>	<b>49</b>
Flavours of wild blackberries and summer fruits. Well-structured, balanced and sophisticated with savoury, leathery notes and a persistent herbaceous finish	
<b>Chianti Classico 2015, Az Agr Poggerino, Tuscany, Italy</b>	<b>49.5</b>
Succulent Sangiovese, bramble & dark cherry fruit & oak notes of mocha & coffee. Rich & juicy palate of plums, blackberries & fleshy cherries. Ripe and delicious	
<b>Black Slate 2016, La Conreria d'Scala Dei, Priorat, Spain</b>	<b>51</b>
60% Garnacha, 35% Carignan and 5% Cabernet Sauvignon. Each wine is made by a different Bodega to illustrate the different terroirs of each town in the area. Elegant, rich and silky. Hints of chocolate, spice and dark fruit on the palate with length to impress.	
<b>Kirchholz 2013, Weninger, Burgenland, Austria</b>	<b>51.5</b>
A biodynamic Blaufrankisch, aged in used oak barrels for 18 months, delivering a refined blend of cherry fruits & blackberries. Soft tannins and a lasting finish. Exceptional quality at this price point if you are looking to try something different!	
<b>Cerasuolo di Vittoria 2015 Cos, Vittoria, Sicily Italy</b>	<b>54</b>
Sicilian blend of indigenous Frappato and Nero d'Avola grapes. Aromas of sweet violets and a whisper of spiced cherries. The wine is very smooth, almost silky and the bright berry flavours cascade over the tongue to their lip-smacking conclusion.	

<b>Barda Pinot Noir 2017, Bodega Chacra, Patagonia, Argentina</b>	<b>58</b>
This classy Pinot is soft & approachable with perfumed aromas of raspberry & strawberry & underlying savoury, vegetal notes with spice. Part ageing in Burgundian oak gives a light creaminess & silky tannic structure	
<b>Maqunia &amp; Tabla Tinto 2015, Maquina &amp; Tabla, Toro, Spain</b>	<b>59.5</b>
It could be said that we are slightly obsessed with this tiny innovative wine producing family. Our third offering is in fact the last vintage of this delicious Garnacha/Tinto de Toro blend and we love it. Damsons, raspberries & chocolate with funky under notes of farmyard. Rich & full	
<b>Chateau Haut-Bergey 2004, Pessac -Leognan, Bordeaux, France</b>	<b>65</b>
A mature but still thriving 14-year-old claret. Classically dry, elegant and savoury, with softly coating tannins, mellow fig and black berry fruit, spice and cigar-box flavours	
<b>Brunello di Montalcino 2013, Fossacolle, Tuscany, Italy</b>	<b>67.5</b>
An excellent Brunello with a dense concentration of fruit and an abundance of dried-berry fruit, chocolate and earth aromas & flavours. Great structure & drinking beautifully now but take another home & pop in your cellar!	
<b>Monteti 2013, Tenuta Monteti, Tuscany, Italy</b>	<b>69</b>
55% Petit Verot, 25% Cab Franc, 20% Cab Sauv. Unmistakably a Super Tuscan, amazingly rich and full bodied. Packed with dark fruit, chocolate, coffee and a good hint of oak. Lovely violet notes from the Petit Verdot on the finish. V.Good!	
<b>Pommard 'Tavannes' 2015, Dom. Fernand &amp; Laurent Pillot, Burgundy, France</b>	<b>72.5</b>
A mouth-filling, perfume-y Pinot Noir from the village of Tavannes in Pommard. Winning cherry fruit, spice and mineral flavours framed by grippy but reassuringly fine tannins. Great length. One to consider if you're trying to convert a devotee of big reds to the pleasures of Burgundy.	
<b>Barolo 'Albe' 2014, Aldo Vajra, Piedmont, Italy</b>	<b>73</b>
A traditional-style but extremely approachable Barolo made from fruit sourced from three different vineyard. Aromas of red fruits and plums, flowers & pine needle. Albe is a harmony of sophisticated and delicate flavours supported by an elegant acidity and ripe tannins.	
<b>Vino Nobile di Montalcino 'Bossona Riserva' 2011, Cantine Dei, Tuscany, Italy</b>	<b>79</b>
A gorgeous, savoury Sangiovese from Dei's best vineyards, aged for a minimum of 18 mths in wood then bottle, an abundance of personality and character. Silky smooth and harmonious	
Cellar Selection (limited quantities)	
<b>Rosso dell' Abazia 2013, Serafini &amp; Vidotto, Veneto, Italy</b>	<b>65</b>
This Italian cult wine is a Bordeaux blend of grapes from North of Venice. The wine is complex and powerful, intense cassis aromas, sweet & concentrated dark berry fruit, savoury hints of tobacco, earth & black olive with herbal, vegetal notes. The palate is rich & beautifully balanced. Mouth-filling fruit with a creamy texture & hints of oak.	
<b>Dominio del Aquila Reserva 2014, Ribera del Duero, Spain</b>	<b>95</b>
A field blend of mainly Tempranillo with small parcels of Bobal & Garnacha from vineyards up to 100 years old. Traditional methods of hand harvesting & foot treading & aged for 31 months in old French barrels in underground caves. Traditional yes but a much fresher style of Ribero.
