- Prosecco Di Conegliano-Valdobbiadene, Bernardi, Veneto, Italy** 29
Clean, fresh and elegant with delicate bubbles that enhance its subtle citrusy fruit and touch of marzipan, dangerously drinkable!
- Tradicional Extra Brut 2015, Colet Vins, Penedes, Spain** 37
Elegant and balanced. Aromas of white flowers & some citrus notes. A creaminess on the palette from time spent on the lees. Its lovely balance between rich & refreshing makes it incredibly food friendly but also a great aperitif.
- Grande Reserve Brut NV, Devaux, Côte des Bar, Champagne, France** 58
A boutique champagne producer specialising in Pinot Noir dominated wines. A lovely richness to the nose, baked apple, vanilla, lively acidity & finesse.
- Ruinart Blanc de Blanc NV, Ruinart, Champagne, France** 100
100% Premier Cru Chardonnay. A nose of brioche, French toast and roasted almonds & on the palate the wine is very supple and harmonious, with notes of honey and minerals on the long, finish. The definition of finesse.
- La Rosita Brut NV, Lobban, Barcelona, Spain** 33.5
Delicious sparkling rosé by a Scottish female winemaker in Spain! Predominantly Grenache & made in the traditional champagne method. Strawberries & cream with nougaty complexity.
- Cuvée Rosé NV, Devaux, Côte des Bar, Champagne, France** 65
A decadent & delicious wine with very fine bubbles, a creamy mouth-feel, raspberries, strawberries & hints of hazelnut.

White

- Gran Cerdo Blanco 2018, Gonzalo Grijalba, Rioja, Spain** 23.5
Beyond the Viura base of this wine, varieties like Sauvignon Blanc and Muscat add some delicious fragrant nuances. A funky, fresh and fruity natural wine.
- Chaval Blanco 2018, Bodegas Nodus, Valencia, Spain** 24
An organic Chardonnay Moscatel blend. Bright floral soft fruit, hints of crisp apple and some ripe pear notes.
- Casa de Paços 2018, Quinta de Paços, Vinho Verde, Portugal** 25.5
A blend of Loureiro & Arinto, Fleshy melon & light tropical fruit on the nose following through to the palate with vibrant acidity and excellent minerality.
- Picpoul de Pinet 2018, Château de la Mirande, Languedoc, France** 26
Referred to as the 'Muscadet of the South', with its minerality & almost saltiness on the nose from its close proximity to the sea. Flavours of pear, citrus fruit & fennel, and a zesty finish.
- Le Bon Cote Blanc 2018, Domaine des Lauriers, Languedoc, France** 27
Surprising complex blend of Vermentino & one of Languedocs oldest varieties Terret. Crisp & aromatic with white flowers and stone fruits.
- Torrentes/Riesling 2018, Amalaya, Salta, Argentina** 27
Intense nose with aromas of citrus and grapefruit typical of Torrentes. Delicate and silky on the palate with great freshness and crisp acidity on the distinctly mineral finish.
- Verdicchio 'Costa Verde' 2018, Tavignana, Italy** 29
Lovely classic style - white peach and floral notes on the nose continuing onto the palate with citrus & stone fruit, finishing with hints of bitter almond.
- Godello Do Monterrei 2018, Mara Martin, Galicia, Spain** 29.5
From one of the most influential producers in Galicia, this delicious and unusual wine from the Godello grape is bone dry with notes of apple & pear and a citrus tang on the finish.
- Les Pierrières 1er Cotes de Blaye 2018, Château Beaumont, Bordeaux, France** 30.5
Sweet grapefruit & subtle buttery notes on the nose, textured & creamy on the palate with tropical notes & lovely tang on the finish. (semillon/sauvignon blend)
- Cora 2018, Loxarel, Penedès, Spain** 31.5
In Greek mythology Cora means a young & virgin maiden – a perfect name for this delicate & elegant wine. A blend of Muscat d'Alexandria & Xarel.lo it has a nose evoking honeysuckle, white flowers tropical fruit & peach. Fresh & silky on the palate with a lingering finish
- Gavi il Forte 2018, Produttori del Gavi, Piemonte, Italy** 31
A well balanced Gavi, with a pale yellow colour, intense floral notes and good minerality. A great refreshing wine for a hot day or the perfect choice to go with some seafood
- Tocai Friulano 'Toh' 2018, Di Lenardo, Friuli Venezia, Italy** 32.5
A gentle and approachable style of Friulano, soft, round and mouth filling. Ripe stone & exotic fruits with hints of spice and almond, a clean balancing mineral acidity and lovely length.
- Hobby 2017, Alentejo, Portugal** 32
100% Antão Vaz, a lovely wine from this hot new region has a rich & complex character from its 4 months in French oak and its wet stone minerality is reminiscent of a fine Chablis.

Riesling 2018, Mehrlein Mittelheimer Edelman, Rheingau, Germany	33
This dry style of Riesling has a pure lime citrus fruit character and a stony minerality. The palate is very precise with just a hint of texture and a cleansing acidity. Perfect as an aperitif or with oily fish dishes.	
Viognier 2019, Maison Nicolas Perrin, Northern Rhone, France	33.5
When the heavyweights like Nicolas Jaboulet and Marc Perrin (Chateau de Beaucautel) meet, the outcome can only be one – fireworks. Aromatic yet fresh, crisp and mineral with a lovely bright finish.	
Malagousia 2017 Mylonas Winery, Attica, Greece	33.5
This aromatic grape variety was rescued from near extinction in the 1970's. It has a lovely nose of white flowers & pear with a herbal hint. Rich on the palate but with balancing acidity. Perfect match to seafood or as an aperitif	
Fiano de Avellino 2017, Lapilli, Campania, Italy	34
A lovely golden yellow colour in the glass leads onto complex aromas of spice, apricot, orange peel, acacia and honey. Good levels of acidity keep the palate fresh and clean.	
Village Chardonnay 2017, Kumeu River, N.Island, New Zealand	37
Kumeu River are virtually NZ wine Royalty, & are world famous for their chardonnays – rivalling great Burgundian white in style with their subtle oak influence & stone like minerality. This village chardonnay is no exception, elegant with a lovely peachy ripeness. Great as an aperitif, even better with fish or shellfish.	
Screaming Betty 2018, Delinquente Wine Co. Riverland, South Australia	37.5
With classic aromas of stone fruit and crisp pear on the nose, this thirst quenching, acid-driven, and textural Vermentino is perfect for summer drinking	
Txakolina 2018, Gaintza, Getaria, Basque Country, Spain	37.5
Traditional Basque Country wine. Fresh herbs, green apple & citrus on the nose. On the palate it is light and has refreshing high acidity & a slight spritz characteristics of Txakoli.	
Arndorfer 'Vorgesmack' 2018, Martin & Anna Arndorfer, Kamptal, Austria	38
A blend of Grüner Veltliner and Riesling. Fresh, lively and well balanced. Dangerously easy drinking!	
Martiena Bianco 2016, Cantine Dei, Tuscany, Italy	39
This blend of Malvasia, Grechetto & Trebbiano has a real tutti frutti nose, tinned peaches and ripe citrus. Crisp bright and juicy on the palate, citrus and fleshy with lovely ripeness and balancing acidity.	
Langhe Bianco 'Dragon' 2018, Luigi Baudana, Piedmont, Italy	39.5
Dry floral and summer grass perfumes are supported by distinct mineral notes and a savoury, lifted character on the palate. Chardonnay & Sauvignon with touches of Riesling and Nascetta giving extra elegance & a lovely finish.	
Weissburgunder 2017, Bender, Germany	39.5
Dry and elegant wine with fine aromas of stone fruit; rich and well balanced on the palate. A lively acidity and freshness provides the right undertone for a pleasant, long finish.	
Paramos de Nicasia 2017, Maquina & Tabla, Toro, Spain	40
A new & exciting small family run winery producing bio dynamic, interesting & finely crafted wines. This Verdejo has a touch of Malvasia and is a sensuously rich, modern Spanish white reminiscent of oaked white Bordeaux.	
Bourgogne Aligote 2018, Goisot, Cotes d'Auxerre, Burgundy, France	40.5
Aligote is the 'other' white grape variety of Burgundy. A complex wine with a nose of lemon & apple as well as notes of flint. On the palate the apple combines with a hint of spice, apricot & a toasty creaminess.	
Albariño 2018, Zarate, Rias Baixa, Spain	44
Minerality and balance in a bottle, very focused and tight, like a good Chablis. Hidden amongst the steely character of the wine, stone fruits such as peach and apricot lurk – totally delicious!	
Gewürztraminer 2017, Lani, Marlborough, New Zealand	44.5
Elegant and aromatic with floral perfumes and sweet spices on the nose. Think Turkish delight and crystallised ginger! Lovely weight & texture on the palate and a sweetness that is finely balanced with its acidity.	
Kerner 2018, Abbazia Di Novacella, Alto Adige, Italy	46
An aromatic varietal aged in large oak barrels. Rich aromas, floral, apricot kernel & peach characters. The palate has great texture and richness with clean balancing citrus acidity. Lovely length.	
Terlaner Classico 2018, Cantina Terlano, Alto Adige, Italy	51
Elegant & harmonious. Ripe tropical flavours, soft white fruit and lovely floral notes with balancing acidity. The wine has a long, persistent finish. (Pinot Bianco/Chard/Sauv)	
Picarana 2018, Marañones, Madrid, Spain	51.5
The Albillo Real variety loves the sunshine seen in its lovely tropical fruit & white flower aromas. Fermentation in oak gives it weight & richness & its minerality keeps it deliciously fresh. This smart smooth wine is a great find.

Cialla Bianco 2016, Ronchi di Cialla, Friuli Venezia-Giulia, Italy	56
A unique blend of Ribolla Gialla, Picolit & Verduzzo Friuliano fermented & aged in barrique & further bottle aged for 20 months. Subtle and elegant with hints of pear, apple, plum and vanilla. Full bodied, well balanced with refined minerality. Graceful & characterful.	

Macon Villages 'Les Sardines' 2017, Domaine Robert Denogent, Burgundy, France	59
Aromas of red apple intertwined with toasty oak and brioche. The palate is precise with superb definition and intensity. It has racy acidity and a long finish. Classic & beautiful example	
Sancerre 'Silex' 2017, Francois Le Saint, Loire, France	67
A stunning Sancerre, biodynamic, organic, grown on classic silex soils of flint & limestone. Pear & apples, citrus zest, aromatic with great intensity. Fab find!

Gran Passione 2018, IGT, Veneto, Italy	33.5
A blend of Corvina & Merlot, much like an Amarone, the grapes are laid out to dry before squeezing to intensify the flavour. Vibrant purple in colour, rich luscious nose full of sweet ripe dark cherry, plum, vanilla and spice. Rich and velvety, with lots of juicy fruit. Very easy drinking.	
Wien 2 2019, Roman Pfaffl, Wienviertel, Austria	34
Delicious blend of Austria's native Zweigelt & Pinot Noir that could be mistaken for a Baby Burgandy. A smoky nose with red berry fruits & spicy notes	
Bourgueil 'Diptyque' 2017, Domaine de la Chevalerie, Loire, France	34.5
This 100% Cabernet Franc is delightful ! Fresh, yet intense, with a floral bouquet and flavours of raspberry and blackberry. Its lovely rounded palate has a nice bite from firm tannins. Perfect with charcuterie and aged cheeses.	
Roxanne the Razor 2018, Delinquente Wine Co. Riverland, South Australia	36.5
A blend of Italian grape varieties, Nero D'Avola gives bright, juicy, dark berry fruit and Montepulciano provides elegant, savoury spice. Effortlessly delicious.	

The Flower & the Bee 2017, Coto de Gomariz, Ribeiro, Spain	37.5
Fresh and bright with assertive cherry and raspberry fruit. Lovely purity and a spicy bite, with high acidity on the finish. 100% Sousón, a beautiful & utterly drinkable wine.	
Rioja Reserva 2015, Izadi, Rioja, Spain	37.5
Shiny ruby red in colour. Rich aromatic intensity and a nice balance of red fruit, liquorice and spices, with hints of smoke in the background. Elegant and round on the palate with a long aftertaste full of floral and ripe fruit notes.	
El Gordito 2013, Lobban Wines, Jumilla, Spain	38
We are a big fan of Pamela Geddes, who also makes our Rosita Brut. Our first tasting note of this Monastell/Shiraz blend was 'that's f****ng good!' – but to put it more eloquently, there is a very savoury backbone to this wine with black berry fruit, spice, toast & ripe tannins. Dangerously drinkable.	
Zinfandel 2016, De Loach, Califorina, USA	38
Dark in colour, this wine is rich with spice on both the nose and palate. Flavours of ripe strawberry, raspberry and blackberry blend nicely with notes of blackcurrant and molasses. This wine is full bodied with soft tannins and lingering ripe flavours of pomegranate on the finish.	
Ruché di Castagnole Monferrato, 2018, Montalbera, Piemonte, Italy - Vegan	39
A delicate, fresh and elegant wine, ruby red in colour with a hint of violet. Very aromatic, with hints of rose petals, raspberries, violets & even stone fruit notes normally associated with white wines. A long finish with fruit and flower supported by a good balance of tannins. A great summer wine that can be served chilled	
Recantina 2018, Serafini & Vidotto, Veneto, Italy	41
Francesco Serafini brought this grape variety back from near extinction & it is gaining somewhat of a following. Perfumed dark blueberry & plum fruits combine with spice & earth and gamey hints. The palate is almost chocolatey, lots going on here. Fresh & powerful finish with lovely balance making you reach for another glass!!	
Xinomavro 2013, Markovitis Winery, Naoussa, Greece	43
In honour of our fabulous chef Georgios and actually because the wine is delicious, we introduce this little Greek number from a small producer famous for his 100% Xinomavro wines. An aromatic variety with good tannic structure often likened at this level to fine Burgundian Pinot or Barolo.	
Kirchholz 2013, Weninger, Burgenland, Austria	45
A biodynamic Blaufrankisch, aged in used oak for 18 months, delivering a refined blend of cherry fruits & blackberries. Soft tannins and a lasting finish. Exceptional quality at this price if you are looking to try something different!	
Phigaia 2016, Serafini & Vidotto, Veneto, Italy	46.5
This Cabernet Franc led Bordeaux blend, spends up to 18 months in oak - notes of sour cherry & liquorice on the nose with warmth & savoury notes on the finish. Round tannins & elegance. Works perfectly with our Iberico meats.	
Obidos Reserva 2014, Quinta das Cerejeiras Reserva, Obidos Region, Portugal	48
The oldest Portuguese wine brand! Over the last 150 years Quinta das Cerejeiras only produces Reserva wines on exceptional years. The wine is aged in French oak barrels for years before release. Its blend of Castelão, Touriga Nacional & Aragonez has rich aromas & focused, developed fruit.	
Rioja Selección 1999, Urbina, Rioja, Spain	48
Old fashioned Rioja at its drinkable best. Almost amber in colour with pronounced & seductive savoury vanilla oak aromas. Concentrated ripe berries on the palate, broadening out to the savoury & sensuous.

- Monteti 2013, Tenuta Monteti, Tuscany, Italy** 65

- Brunello di Montalcino 2015, Fossacolle, Tuscany, Italy** 72
An excellent Brunello with a dense concentration of fruit and an abundance of dried-berry fruit, chocolate and earth aromas & flavours. Great structure & drinking beautifully now but take another home & pop in your cellar!
- Barolo ‘Albe’ 2015, Aldo Vajra, Piedmont, Italy** 73
A traditional-style but extremely approachable Barolo made from fruit sourced from three different vineyard. Aromas of red fruits and plums, flowers & pine needle. Albe is a harmony of sophisticated and delicate flavours supported by an elegant acidity and ripe tannins.
- Pommard ‘Tavannes’ 2015, Dom. Fernand & Laurent Pillot, Burgundy, France** 78
A mouth-filling, perfume-y Pinot Noir from the village of Tavannes in Pommard. Winning cherry fruit, spice and mineral flavours framed by grippy but reassuringly fine tannins. Great length. One to consider if you’re trying to convert a devotee of big reds to the pleasures of Burgundy.
- Vino Nobile di Montalcino ‘Bossona Riserva’ 2013, Cantine Dei, Tuscany, Italy** 89
A gorgeous, savoury Sangiovese from Dei’s best vineyards, aged for a minimum of 18 mths in wood then bottle, an abundance of personality and character. Silky smooth and harmonious

- Dominio Blanco 2015, Dominio de Aguila, Ribera del Duero, Spain** 105
This stunning Ribera white is so interesting & complex. The Albillo grapes are sourced from ancient vines, fermented in French oak barrels & aged in concrete vats. The nose is savoury with flint & the smokiness of a fine single malt. The fruit is peaches & lemon & the mouthfeel is creamy but with a balancing acidity. As much power & complexity as any Red Ribera – so so delicious.
- Pinot Noir ‘Grillenhugel’ 2011, Johanneshof Reinisch, Thermenregion, Austria** 69
The climate & limestone soils make for the ideal conditions for this charming single vineyard Pinot. Raspberries & hints of caramel from its 16 months oak aging. Elegant, silky tannins & great complexity
- Chateau du Tours 2015, Cotes du Rhone Reserve, Rhone, France** 71
Nestled between Vacqueyras & Chateaneuf-du-Pape & made by renowned winemaker Emmanuel Reynaud, this wine is everything a Rhone red should be – deep seductive berry fruit & spice, it manages to be both rich & full, and supple & silky. Alongside all the hearty generosity of its neighbours it also has a subtle seductive charming texture.
- Gevrey Chambertin 2012, Domaine Thierry Mortet, Burgundy, France** 86
Thierry’s 2011 is an unapologetically ‘easy’ Gevrey with succulent cassis fruit and an undercurrent of woodland savour. The tannins have now melted together to give this a gorgeously supple frame. This is very hard not to love.
- Brunello di Montalcino 2014, Fuligni, Tuscany, Italy** 110
Lovers of serious Sangiovese need look no further than Fulignis classic Brunello. Elegant rose petal & cherry character with mushroom undertones. Velvety tannins & and a lovely savoury finish. Delicious, solid and harmonious wine.
- Granja Gran Reserva 2010, Remelluri, Rioja, Spain** 99
Only produced in the best vintages this prestigious Rioja doesn’t disappoint. An expressive nose of cherries, dark plums, liquorice & vanilla. Full bodied yet elegant with round tannic structure. Concentrated & complex with a lasting finish. Deliciously indulgent
