- Cava Brut Reserva 2020 Bodegas Sumarroca, Penedes, Spain** 35
This classy Cava will satisfy fans of Champagnes classic yeasty characteristics. A rich, full, complex & toasty Cava that's fresh on the palette with fine persistent bubbles.
- Grande Reserve Brut NV, Devaux, Côte des Bar, Champagne, France** 68
A boutique champagne producer specialising in Pinot Noir dominated wines. A lovely richness to the nose, baked apple, vanilla, lively acidity & finesse.
- Larmandier-Bernier 'Longitude' Blanc de Blanc premier cru NV, Champagne, France** 105
100% Premier Cru Chardonnay. A nose of brioche, French toast and roasted almonds & on the palate the wine is very supple and harmonious, with notes of honey and minerals on the long, finish. The definition of finesse.
- La Rosita Brut NV, Lobban, Barcelona, Spain** 36
Delicious sparkling rosé by a Scottish female winemaker in Spain! Predominantly Grenache & made in the traditional champagne method. Strawberries & cream with nougaty complexity.

A decadent & delicious wine with very fine bubbles, a creamy mouth-feel, raspberries, strawberries & hints of hazelnut.

- Old Vine Macabeo 2022, Enterro, Manchuela, Spain** 29
An organic Macabeo full of character. Orange blossom & tropical fruit. A joyful, clean, crisp & easy drinking white.
- Gran Cerdo Blanco 2022, Gonzalo Grijalba, Rioja, Spain** 30
Beyond the Viura base of this wine, varieties like Sauvignon Blanc and Muscat add some delicious fragrant nuances. A funky, fresh and fruity natural wine.
- En la Parra Blanco 2022, Bodegas Nodus, Valencia, Spain** 30
An organic Chardonnay Moscatel blend. Bright floral soft fruit, hints of crisp apple and some ripe pear notes.
- Vinho Verde 2022, Espigueiro Casa Agricola de Compostela, Portugal** 31
Made from handpicked local grapes Arinto, Trajadura & Loureiro. Light with refreshing acidity, peach and nectarine notes on the nose. A perfect aperitif that goes down far too easily!
- Picpoul de Pinet 2022, Château de la Mirande, Languedoc, France** 34
Referred to as the 'Muscadet of the South', with its minerality & almost saltiness on the nose from its close proximity to the sea. Flavours of pear, citrus fruit & fennel, and a zesty finish.

In Greek mythology Cora means a young and virgin maiden – a perfect name for this delicate & elegant wine. A blend of Muscat d'Alexandria & Xarel.lo it has a nose evoking honeysuckle, white flowers tropical fruit & peach. Fresh & silky on the palate with a lingering finish
- Viognier 2022, Le Cabanon, Maison des Alexandrins, Northern Rhone, France** 39
When the heavyweights like Nicolas Jaboulet and Marc Perrin (Chateau de Beaucastel) meet, the outcome can only be one – fireworks. Aromatic yet fresh, crisp and mineral with a lovely bright finish.
- Fiano 2022, Caiaffa, Puglia, Italy** 40
Inviting, aromatic nose of apricot, honey and white flowers. Silky mouthfeel with good levels of acidity to keep the palate fresh and clean.
- Wien 1 2022, Pfaffl, Austria** 40.5
A traditional Viennese blend of Riesling, pinot blanc & gruner veltliner. Fresh, lively and well balanced. Dangerously easy drinking!
- Les Pierrières 1er Cotes de Blaye 2021, Château Beaumont, Bordeaux, France** 41
Sweet grapefruit & subtle buttery notes on the nose, textured & creamy on the palate with tropical notes & lovely tang on the finish. (semillon/sauvignon blend)

This aromatic grape variety was rescued from near extinction in the 1970's. It has a lovely nose of white flowers & pear with a herbal hint. Rich on the palate but with balancing acidity. Perfect match to seafood or as an aperitif

A blend of Corvina & Merlot, much like an Amarone, the grapes are laid out to dry before squeezing to intensify the flavour. Vibrant purple in colour, rich luscious nose full of sweet ripe dark cherry, plum, vanilla and spice. Rich and velvety, with lots of juicy fruit. Very easy drinking.	
Wien 2 2022, Roman Pfaffl, Wienviertel, Austria	41
Delicious blend of Austria's native Zweigelt & Pinot Noir that could be mistaken for a Baby Burgandy. A smoky nose with red berry fruits & spicy notes	
Old Vine Shiraz 2022, Thistledown, South Australia	41.5
The shiraz is fermented with a small percentage of aromatic white Zibibbo to make this delicious & different shiraz. Notes of nectarine, raspberry & spice on the nose. Soft & silky on the palette and dangerously drinkable.	
Brio 2021, Castello Romitorio, Tuscany, Italy	42
A bit like the art on the label (the winery is owned by Italian artist Sandro Chia) this oak aged sangiovese is colourful with notes of ripe cherry, raspberries and warm Tuscan earth, all accompanied by delicious acidity and seamless drinkability.	
Bourgueil 'Franco de Porc' 2019, Domaine de la Chevalerie, Loire, France	42
This 100% Cabernet Franc is delightful! Fresh, yet intense, with a floral bouquet and flavours of raspberry and blackberry. Its lovely, rounded palate has a nice bite from firm tannins. Perfect with charcuterie and aged cheeses.	
Zinfandel 2020, De Loach, California, USA	43
Dark in colour, this wine is rich with spice on both the nose and palate. Flavours of ripe strawberry, raspberry and blackberry blend nicely with notes of blackcurrant and molasses. This wine is full bodied with soft tannins and lingering ripe flavours of pomegranate on the finish.	
El Gordito 2017, Lobban Wines, Jumilla, Spain	44
We are a big fan of Pamela Geddes, who also makes our Rosita Brut. The Monastrell/Syrah blend has a very savoury backbone to this wine with black berry fruit, spice, toast & ripe tannins. Dangerously drinkable.	
Roxanne the Razor 2022, Delinquent Wine Co. Riverland, South Australia	46.5
A blend of Italian grape varieties, Nero D'Avola gives bright, juicy, dark berry fruit and Montepulciano provides elegant, savoury spice. Effortlessly delicious.	
Rioja Reserva 2018, Izadi, Rioja, Spain	47
Shiny ruby red in colour. Rich aromatic intensity and a nice balance of red fruit, liquorice and spices, with hints of smoke in the background. Elegant and round on the palate with a long aftertaste full of floral and ripe fruit notes.	
The Flower & the Bee 2020, Coto de Gomariz, Ribeiro, Spain	47
Fresh and bright with assertive cherry and raspberry fruit. Lovely purity and a spicy bite, with high acidity on the finish. 100% Sousón, a beautiful & utterly drinkable wine.

'Arom' offers a superbly balanced expression of Garnacha with bright and fragrant aromas of blackcurrant, white pepper and thyme, supported by firm tannins and beautiful freshness, quite unlike a traditional Spanish Garnacha.

In honour of our fabulous chef Georgios and actually because the wine is delicious, we introduce this little Greek number from a small producer famous for his 100% Xinomavro wines. An aromatic variety with good tannic structure often likened at this level to fine Burgundian Pinot or Barolo.

This Cabernet Franc led Bordeaux blend, spends up to 18 months in oak - notes of sour cherry & liquorice on the nose with warmth & savoury notes on the finish. Round tannins & elegance. Works perfectly with our Iberico meats.	
Bugalugs Shiraz 2020, Tim Smith Wines, Barossa, South Australia	58
An Aussie term of endearment is quite fitting to this delicious, perfectly balanced but no- nonsense Barossa Shiraz. Blackberries, pepper, dark chocolate, mint & truffley goodness. Yum!	
Fleurie 2021, Clos de la Roquette, Beaujolais, France	59
From one of the finest domaines in Beaujolais. A touch of smokiness & spice, cherries & blackberry fruit. Beautifully rich on the palate, fine tannins, balanced & long	
Chianti Classico 2021, Az Agr Poggerino, Tuscany, Italy	61
Succulent Sangiovese, bramble & dark cherry fruit & oak notes of mocha & coffee. Rich & juicy palate of plums, blackberries & fleshy cherries. Ripe and delicious	
Pessac-Leognan 2019, Domaine de Chevalier, Bordeaux, France	62
The little brother of Domaine de Chevalier, but even at this level the sophistication is apparent. Very sumptuous nose with supple ripe fruit and the excellent freshness and acidity. It's a joy of a classic claret from a cool terroir.	
Rioja Reserva Especial 2006, Urbina, Rioja, Spain	64
Old fashioned Rioja at its drinkable best. Almost amber in colour with pronounced & seductive savoury vanilla oak aromas. Concentrated ripe berries on the palate, broadening out to the savoury & sensuous.	
Cerasuolo di Vittoria 2020 Cos, Vittoria, Sicily Italy	66
Sicilian blend of indigenous Frappato and Nero d'Avola grapes. Aromas of sweet violets and a whisper of spiced cherries. The wine is very smooth, almost silky and the bright berry flavours cascade over the tongue to their lip-smacking conclusion.	
Barda Pinot Noir 2021, Bodega Chacra, Patagonia, Argentina	72
This classy Pinot is soft & approachable with perfumed aromas of raspberry & strawberry & underlying savoury, vegetal notes with spice. Part ageing in Burgundian oak gives a light creaminess & silky tannic structure	
Brao 2017, Vinyes Velles Nobles, Montsant, Spain	75
80% Carignan & 20% Garnacha. Aromas of plums and cherries, dried fruit and hints of violets, this seductive red wine named after the local word for "courage", Brao is the kind of wine which strengthens and nourishes both body & soul with its the harmonious combination of sensuous dark fruit, silky smooth texture and gentle tannins.	
Monteti 2017, Tenuta Monteti, Tuscany, Italy	80
55% Petit Verot, 25% Cab Franc, 20% Cab Sauv. Unmistakably a Super Tuscan, amazingly rich and full bodied. Packed with dark fruit, chocolate, coffee and a good hint of oak. Lovely violet notes from the Petit Verdot on the finish. V.Good!	
Plaer 2017, Ritme Celler, Priorat, Spain	82
Aged in French Oak for 12 months, it is rich and full flavoured, deeply fleshed with blackberry and plum fruits. The Llicorella soils of Priorat, decomposing slate, allow the wines to retain a freshness and add a sense of something mineral, there are also notes of liquorice and chocolate. Barolo 'Albe' 2019, Aldo Vajra, Piedmont, Italy	93
A traditional-style but extremely approachable Barolo made from fruit sourced from three different vineyard. Aromas of red fruits and plums, flowers & pine needle. Albe is a harmony of sophisticated and delicate flavours supported by an elegant acidity and ripe tannins.	
Pommard 'Tavannes' 2018, Dom. Fernand & Laurent Pillot, Burgundy, France	97
A mouth-filling, perfume-y Pinot Noir from the village of Tavannes in Pommard. Winning cherry fruit, spice and mineral flavours framed by grippy but reassuringly fine tannins. Great length. One to consider if you're trying to convert a devotee of big reds to the pleasures of Burgundy.	
Vino Nobile di Montalcino 'Bossona Riserva' 2017, Cantine Dei, Tuscany, Italy	109
A gorgeous, savoury Sangiovese from Dei's best vineyards, aged for a minimum of 18 months in wood then bottle, an abundance of personality and character. Silky smooth and harmonious

Fresh and lively aromas, perfumed and floral with elderflower & grapey notes. The palate is sweet with light fizz and balancing citrus steely acidity. Clean and delightfully fresh. Ideal breakfast, lunch & dinner.	
Muscat de Rivesaltes 2020, Chateau de Jau, Languedoc, France (500ml)	38
Gloriously fresh aromas of orange-flower, crushed grapes and crystallised fruits; the apparent sweetness is more than offset by a bitter, tangy finish.	
Monastrell Dulce 2018, Bodega Castano, Yecla, Spain (500ml)	41
Perfumed and floral, liquorice and pepper with an exploding burst of blueberries, cassis, cherries, chocolate and spice

White

- Flors di Uis 2020, Vie di Romans, Friuli-Venezia Giulia, Italy** 77
Intense aromas of wisteria and sweet jasmine, balanced with light spicy notes. The full-bodied palate shows surprising power while the natural zest of Riesling ensures fresh and vibrant acidity. Wonderfully long and aromatic. (Malvasia Istriana, Riesling, Tocai Friulano)
- Chenin Blanc 2021, Damascene, Stellenbosch, South Africa** 81
Aromatics of waxy flowers, lime, honey and wet stone. Harmonious stone fruit on the palate - white peaches, apricot & mango. The mineral acidity carries all the richness of the fruit into a refreshing finish with hints of toasty nuts on the finish. Indulgent & delicious.
- Chardonnay 2018, Darling Wines, Sonoma, California, USA** 93
Inspired by some of the great producers in Chablis and Burgundy, whole bunch pressed & using very little new oak. The wine is elegant & fresh but with gorgeous enticing notes of lemon & butter. DELICIOUS
- Dominio Blanco 2019, Dominio de Aguila, Ribera del Duero, Spain** 120
This stunning Ribera white is so interesting & complex. The Albillo grapes are sourced from ancient vines, fermented in French oak barrels & aged in concrete vats. The nose is savoury with flint & the smokiness of a fine single malt. The fruit is peaches & lemon & the mouthfeel is creamy but with a balancing acidity. As much power & complexity as any Red Ribera – so so good.

Red

- Syrah 2021, Damascene, Swartland, South Africa** 81
One of the top Syrahs coming out of S.A. From vineyards in the clouds, a style with alluring aromas of wild herbs and sweet spices, a dense, layered palate of fig and blackberry, lots of energy, grip and minerality and a finish that carries on the palate. World class
- Gevrey Chambertin 2019, Domaine Thierry Mortet, Burgundy, France** 93
Thierry's 2011 is an unapologetically 'easy' Gevrey with succulent cassis fruit and an undercurrent of woodland savour. The tannins have now melted together to give this a gorgeously supple frame. This is very hard not to love.
- Dash Farm Cabernet Sauvignon 2021, Joshua Cooper, Victoria, Australia** 97
The mountainside nature of Dash Farm provides incredible freshness to the wine. Deep, inky purple with intense violet and cassis, Gentle, silk-velvet texture, lots of lush dark fruit sweet herb and spice on the palette. Very 'Claret' in style.
- Granja Gran Reserva 2014, Remelluri, Rioja, Spain** 101
Only produced in the best vintages this prestigious Rioja doesn't disappoint. An expressive nose of cherries, dark plums, liquorice & vanilla. Full bodied yet elegant with round tannic structure. Concentrated & complex with a lasting finish. Deliciously indulgent
- Châteauneuf du Pape 2019, 'Les Trois Sources', Domaine de la Vieille Julienne, S.Rhone, France** 137
The 2015 Trois Source is simply gorgeous. Black raspberries, black liquorice, violets and loads of salty minerality all emerge from this seamless, ultra-fine beauty that has incredible purity and polish to its tannin. Full-bodied, concentrated and perfectly balanced, it's one of the most layered, interesting and enjoyable wines in the vintage.
- Brunello di Montalcino 2017, Fuligni, Tuscany, Italy** 146
Lovers of serious Sangiovese need look no further than Fuligni's classic Brunello. Elegant rose petal & cherry character with mushroom undertones. Velvety tannins & a lovely savoury finish. Delicious, solid and harmonious wine.
